

Earlier Ranger Users

The security software Ranger, (www.rangersuite.co.uk). Two back slashes followed by the servers name in any type of explorer, e.g. internet explorer, windows explorer etc, is blocked by Ranger. The security is in place to stop anyone using back doors to servers.

There is a section in the security software that allows "Exceptions to Explorer Title Check". Type the servers name followed by the path to the software's folder, e.g. [\\education\applic\apps\Lwsall](#). It allows network users to access the contents of this one folder but no other folders on the network.

Using Living Worksheets on a network with Excel 2010

Note from a current user

We use Ranger to manage the permissions for our users. I added some registry entries to the end of the "preshellINT.rrg" and "preshellVista.rrg" files, in the Ranger root folder, to tell Excel the location of Living Worksheets has trusted files thus not requiring the user to enable macros every time they login.

;Add Living Worksheets to trusted location in Excel2010  
[HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Microsoft\Office\14.0\Excel\Security\Trusted Locations\Location6]  
"AllowSubFolders"=dword:00000001  
"Path"="<location of share - remember to add \\ for every \ in the folders path>"  
"Description"="Trusted Public Apps Folder"
```

Note the second registry location (Location6) may require the System Admin to increment the number depending on the current amount of trusted locations already set in Excel 2010.

We also added the Living Worksheets shortcut to each groups startmenu within the Ranger Administrator program.
